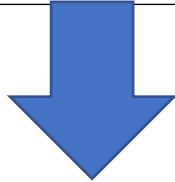


# BEHAVIOUR RESPONSE PROCESS:

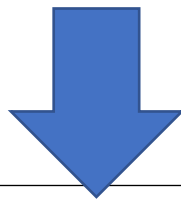
## STEP 1 – YELLOW CARD

Given as a verbal warning – YP will be told what about their behaviour needs to be adjusted.



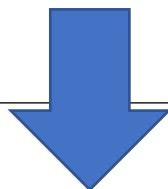
## STEP 2 – 2<sup>ND</sup> YELLOW CARD

Given as a second verbal warning – YP may be taken to one side to remind them that their behaviour is still unacceptable and needs to be adjusted.



## STEP 3 – RED CARD

The YP will be asked to sit out of activities for a specified time, to reflect on their behaviour. Should they wish to rejoin the group/activity, an apology will be expected with a response to how their behaviour was not acceptable.



## REMOVAL FROM GROUP

Unacceptable Behaviour – At this point, if behaviour has not improved after Step 3 intervention, then parents/guardians will be called and YP will be removed from the group.

**NON ADMITTANCE TO GROUP / INSTANT REMOVAL:** This will occur in the following, but limited to, the following circumstances:

- \*Concern about a YP mental state (this may include mental ill health, possible drug/alcohol influence etc)
- \*Concern for a YP's physical wellbeing (if they seem unwell, high temperature etc)
- \*Fighting or Bullying (including physical, verbal & non verbal, social media etc..)
